Overall Goal of the Coalition of Action 4 Soil Health (CA4SH)

To improve soil health globally by addressing critical implementation, monitoring, policy, and investment barriers that constrain farmers from scaling healthy soil practices.

The four targets of the Coalition:

- Integrate soil health considerations in policy across the development, environment, agriculture and climate change domains.
- **Expand research in development** on soil health practices and monitoring.
- Significantly **increase** the number of hectares of **land under healthy soil practices**.
- Significantly **increase investments in soil health**, by a margin of 5-10 fold above current financing commitments.

Objectives of the Working Groups

- Working groups will enable CA4SH to achieve its objectives in line with its four main goals
- Continue positioning the role of soil health across domains, drawing on the expertise to align and advance the mandates of the partners
- Map out and lead collaborative actions for 2024
- Each working group working independently toward key thematic objectives whilst identifying synergies







ObjectivesPolicy and enabling environment for soil health

- Identify **strategic policy opportunities** and **entry points** for soil health
- Advocate for government backing to scale soil health globally ensure that soil health is a core thematic priority within global and national level policy frameworks
- Carve a clear roadmap for action on soil health both within global and national level policy framework



Main focus for 2024 Policy and enabling environment for soil health

- Brainstorm entry points and develop policy briefs for each event to ensure work is action-oriented
- Develop policy briefs/recommendations for for countries to include events soil organic carbon in Nationally Determined Contributions (NDCsà
- Case studies integrating soil health in national policy
- Conduct mapping of national soil health planning
- Develop deep dives connecting NDCs to biodiversity targets and action plans - monitor indicators
- Reach out to countries that have endorsed the <u>UAE Food Systems</u>

- Bring clarity and harmonization in soil health monitoring
- Identify tools and financing opportunities to make soil health data measurable, accessible, comparable, and exchangeable
- Identify key challenges and opportunities for monitoring and implementation



Main focus for 2024 Soil health monitoring, research & implementation

- Drive alignment and harmonization of soil health definitions indicators, metrics, tools/methods to assess and monitor soil health
- Spotlight case studies
- Fundraise to implement and track interventions, monitoring and communication
- Bring evidence-based data into policy







ENGAGEMENT, OUTREACH AND COMMUNICATIONS

Objectives Engagement & Outreach

- Make **connections between the SDGs through soil** and communicate them through the CA4SH communications channels
- Have a presence at major events (including the three CoPs)
- Develop communications materials and campaigns that bring soil health to wider audiences



Main focus for 2024 Engagement & Outreach

- **Soil+ SDGs campaign** building a <u>Resource Centre</u> with resources available for each SDG linking to soil health
- A series of **good practice, lessons learned and policy briefs** to collecting and disseminate knowledge from across the Coalition
- Timeline of soil health achievements over time
- Thematic op-ed series







FINANCE AND INVESTMENTS FOR SOIL HEALTH

ObjectivesFinance and investments for soil health

- Catalyze evidence-based public and private investment in soil health
- Drive alignment of key stakeholders to collectively address investment barriers and the soil health investment gap
- Develop and identify tools and mechanisms to support investments in soil health
- Identify **funding opportunities**



Main focus for 2024 Finance and investments for soil health

- Explore how CA4SH can be a mechanism for operationalizing the World Business Council for Sustainable Development (WBCSD)'s Soil Investment Hub
- Identify and drive alignment in investment mechanisms
- Co-develop pitch decks to identify funding opportunities
